Before joining Fox Chase Cancer Center, Dr. Swaby was an Assistant Professor at the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute in Tampa, FL. Anderson Cancer Center and her Residency in Internal Medicine at the University of Maryland Medical System in Baltimore, MD.
