Dr. Robert P. Sticca is the Chairman, Program Director and Director of Surgical Oncology at the University of North Dakota School of Medicine and Health Sciences and is also an Executive Partner of Surgical Services for the Meritcare Health System in Fargo, North Dakota.

Prior to joining the University of North Dakota, Dr. Sticca held faculty positions with Clemson University, the Medical University of South Carolina, and the University of South Carolina School of Medicine. As a Major in the United States Air Force Medical Corps, Dr. Sticca received numerous awards including the Air Force Achievement Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, and the National Defense Service Medal.

Dr. Sticca served on the editorial board for the *Journal of Clinical Oncology* and as a journal referee for several journals including the *Annals of Surgical Oncology*, *Cancer Chemotherapy and Pharmacology*, *Journal of the American College of Surgeons* and the *Journal of Surgical Oncology*. To date, Dr. Sticca has had over 65 original articles, editorials, and book chapters published. Dr. Sticca has been the Principal Investigator (PI), co-PI or collaborator on several grants, including those from the National Science Foundation and the American Medical Association Foundation. Dr. Sticca has been involved in clinical research with the North Central Cancer Treatment Group, the National Surgical Adjuvant Breast and Bowel Project (NSABP), and is currently a PI for the American College of Surgeons Oncology Group.

Dr. Sticca received his undergraduate degree from the University of New Hampshire and his Medical Degree from the University of Connecticut School of Medicine. He completed his internship and residency in General Surgery from the Boston University Surgical Training Program and a subsequent fellowship in Surgical Oncology at the Roswell Park Cancer Institute.
