## Nicholas J. Vogelzang, MD

Nicholas J. Vogelzang, MD, is Chair and Medical Director of the Developmental Therapeutics Committee and Co-Chair of the Genitourinary Committee for US Oncology Research. He also serves as Vice Chair of the Southwest Oncology Group Genitourinary Oncology Committee and is Clinical Professor of Medicine at the University of Nevada School of Medicine in Las Vegas, Nevada.

His primary research interests include clinical trials for genitourinary malignancies, including prostate cancer and with new drugs (developmental therapeutics). At the University of Chicago he was Director of the University of Chicago Cancer Research Center from 1999 to 2003 and held the Fred C. Buffett endowed chair in genitourinary oncology. He served as its principal investigator for Cancer and Leukemia Group B (CALGB) from 1988 to 1999

and was the founding Chair of the CALGB Prostate Committee.

Dr. Vogelzang received his medical degree from the University of Illinois at Chicago and completed his internship, residency, and chief residency in internal medicine at Rush-Presbyterian-St. Luke's Medical Center in Chicago. He served as a faculty member at the University of Chicago from 1982 to 2003, and was the Founding Director of the Nevada Cancer Institute from 2004-2009.

Dr. Vogelzang has served on numerous committees of the American Society of Clinical Oncology, as well as its Board of Directors from 1993 to 1996. He has also served on the editorial boards of *Cancer*, *Cancer Research*, *Clinical Genitourinary Cancer*, *Kidney Cancer Journal*, *The Prostate Journal*, and *the Journal of Clinical Oncology* and is a reviewer for numerous other journals. He is the author of over 400 scientific publications. As a survivor of Hodgkin's disease, he is also a highly sought-after public speaker.
