Age Requirement for Attendees

Because of the detailed nature of the programs and forums, no one under the age of 18 will be admitted to any official Symposium function. This includes, but is not limited to, all Symposium sessions and the Exhibit Hall.

Important Security and Attendee Conduct Information

For security reasons, the 2009 ASCO EHR Symposium badge will be required for admittance to all events. Please wear your badge so that it can be easily seen at all times. Lost badges should be reported to the Registration staff immediately. The following badge policies will be in effect throughout the Symposium:

1. The 2009 ASCO EHR Symposium badge is the sole property of the ASCO.
2. The badge is nontransferable
3.
